
Internship Track

Teaching & Research Track

- For students seeking careers in academia
- Guaranteed for all students admitted before Fall 2020.
 For students admitted in and after Fall 2020, T&R Track limited to graduates of Humanities programs
- 1:1 teaching schedule
- Teaching should be arranged with your department well before the start of your appointment

Internship Track

- For students seeking careers outside academia.
- Competitive application process
- Internships available in units on campus.
- Full time, 40hrs/week
- Internship opportunities can be found on the 5+1 website in November*

Appointment Process

- Appointment normally August 1 May 31
 - For those that start in January due to a 1 semester medical leave/ childbirth accommodation: 2 semesters, no summer support
- Complete <u>Indication of Interest Form</u>
- Communicate early and often with your graduate program coordinator
 - Progress toward degree, teaching plan
- Department will create postdoc appointment packet
